


An automated onboarding system in Asana that cut project chaos and gave back 10+ hours weekly to the agency founder."



The Workflow: Built for Clarity, Not Chaos

This is a fully automated onboarding and project execution system I designed inside Asana for a creative marketing agency. The goal was to eliminate chaos during client onboarding, streamline communication across teams, and ensure nothing falls through the cracks from the welcome email to the final performance report.

I broke the workflow into five clear stages:

- 1. Client Intake & Kickoff
- 2. Strategy & Asset Collection
- 3. Setup & Execution
- 4. Launch & Review
- 5. Final Handover

Each section includes pre-assigned tasks, start/end dates, custom fields (status, stage, priority), and clear ownership.

But the magic?

I added automation throughout the system. Tasks are automatically assigned, status changes trigger next steps, and reminders keep everyone on track with zero micromanagement.

I also created visual dashboards that give clients a bird's-eye view of task progress, overdue items, and section-by-section breakdowns.

This project isn't just a checklist. It's a living system built to run itself and scale with ease.

What This System Delivered

- Reduced onboarding time by up to 50%
- Improved team accountability and transparency with clear ownership
- Enabled automated task handoffs and progress tracking
- Gave the agency real-time visibility into task status and deadlines
- Freed up the founder's time from micromanaging operations
